2015 was something of a textbook vintage for the reds. Tasting in Burgundy cellars in June and November 2016, the '15s were a real pleasure, often difficult to spit out, they offer so much pleasure. Stylistically I would say they are somewhere between the opulence of 2009, and the minerality, precision and freshness of the 2010. They are rather grand, fruit-laden wines, but their opulence has not tipped them over into simplicity. Their complexity – tasting in barrel – is generally open and fragrant. The reds will have broad appeal, to hardcore Burgundy enthusiasts and casual drinkers alike. This is a must year for laying down serious top level wines, but it is also a year to in which to stock up on lower level wines for everyday drinking.

For the 2015 whites I think it will be more a matter of personal taste. The wines seem to offer very round generous fruit, mid-palate weight and citrus through to stone fruit flavours. I think they will offer a lot of appeal for early to mid-term drinking. If you are looking for something more classically styled and for longer term cellaring, you should look now at acquiring what remains of the 2014 stocks, as this was a truly outstanding year for whites in the classical style.

Many full vintage reports have already been published that offer an excellent detailed explanation of the vintage as it unfolded. I won't repeat all the details here, lest to say the key feature was a hot dry season broken by a little welcome rain in August that helped retain freshness. Pretty much everyone we met making reds in the Cote de Nuits was somewhere between happy and thrilled with the quality. The producers of whites in the Cote de Beaune faced a bigger challenge in choosing when to harvest, balancing phenolic development and rising sugars at the end of August.

DOMAINE AUDIFFRED

Henri Audiffred runs this 5 hectare estate in Vosne-Romanee. He took up the reins in 2003, and began working full time at his own estate in 2007 after 14 years working at Domaine de la Romanee-Conti. He has since applied what he learned at The Domaine in vineyard cultivation to apply to his own estate. Vinification is quite different however – his

search for the natural expression of the terroir has led him to adopt 100% de-stemming, fermentation with natural yeasts following a brief cold soak, and then only used barrels are used for élevage. The result is wines with a kind of direct authenticity, and no make up.

The status of this Vosne-Romanée superstar has continued rise as the reins have been passed from Sylvain to Sebastien Cathiard. The market cannot get enough of their wines. Of course, everyone wants some of their RSV or Malconsorts in their cellar, but the quality runs all the way through the range, with wines like the Vosne village, the Clos de l'Orme, and NSG Thorey offering very good value for the quality.

CHARLES VAN CANNEYT

Charles van Canneyt is a rising star in Burgundy. Though only 28 years old, for some time now he has been making waves and garnering high scores for his wines at Domaine Hudelot-Noëllat (see also Hudelot-Noëllat offer below). Since 2012 he has been making small quantities (25 barrels in 2014) of very fine 'micro-négoce' wines from top Burgundy appellations. These are impressive wines, worthy of a place in your cellar. The style is very clear, very precise, with good fruit and finesse, and each plot distinguishable when tasted side by side (as we had the pleasure to do in November 2016).

DOMAINE COQUARD-LOISON-FLEUROT

This is something of a surprise domaine. The land holdings are extraordinary, with no less than six grands crus in the Côtes de Nuits. But for many years "CLF", as it is often referred to, sat behind the scenes, supplying négociants. But it is

today making a name for itself for quality domaine-issued wines, under the new, talented leadership of Claire Fluerot, and winemaker Thomas Colladot. Prices have not yet caught up with quality. Clos de la Roche for HK\$800 a bottle anyone?

DOMAINE DUROCHÉ

The most exciting 'discovery' for Mike, Linden and the team in 2015 was a bottle of 2013 Charmes-Chambertin from Duroché. Meant as a sample to taste and evaluate, within a few minutes we had finished off the bottle! Pierre Duroché is another of the exciting new generation in Burgundy, fifth generation at the estate, and totally focused on Gevrey-Chambertin, where he has 8.25ha spread over several vineyards. The wines are exceptionally good, and in our view challenge the most illustrious names in the village. You can see, for example, from their range of Gevrey village-level lieu dits offerings that they truly love their *terroir*. Tasting at the domaine it is easy to sympathize with why they don't blend them. (Neither does Jean-Marc Roulot in Meursault!). The buzz surrounding Duroché has been growing. Here is your chance for some coveted 2015s.

DOMAINE FOURRIER / JEAN-MARIE FOURRIER

A domaine that today requires no introduction, Jean-Marie Fourier's wines have acquired cult status amongst Burgundy enthusiasts. Tasting in his cellar is a revelation. Extreme meticulousness in the vineyard is his secret, then relative simplicity in winemaking. Henri Mayer was his mentor (he worked the 1988 vintage). Aromatic and fruit intensity are hallmarks, combined with textural finesse.

DOMAINE JEAN GRIVOT

One of the Côte de Nuit's great domaines, with vineyard holdings across Nuits, Vosne, and Chambolle, as well as grands crus Clos de Vougeot, Échezeaux and Richebourg. Quality here has been lifted to new heights in recent vintages as a focus on purity and finesse has been prioritized. This has been a vintage-by-vintage step-by-step process explains Mathilde Grivot, the recent introduction of the latest type of de-stemmer, she said "obtains berries like caviar". Tasting in Mathilde and her father Etienne's cellar, and most recently with Mathilde in our shop, it is clear that this is a domaine on top, with pure wines of great finesse and typicity.

DOMAINE HUDELLOT-NOËLLAT

One of Burgundy's finest domaines in land holdings, but also wines. In the past couple of years the chance to taste ex-domaine cellared bottles of Richebourg and Romanée-St-Vivant from vintages like 1978, 1980, 1985 and 1990, it is clear that these are amongst the most compelling examples of any domaine and of a very classical style. Charles van Canneyt took over from his grandfather Alain Hudelot-Noëllat in 2008, and has proven himself more than a safe pairs of hands with such jewel appellations. Quality here is very high, and the sense of finesse increased. We tasted the 2015s here in November 2016 - they are outstanding.

DOMAINE LAMARCHE



Together with Domaine de la Romanée-Conti and Liger-Belair, one of three domaines to hold a monopole grand crus in Vosne-Romanée, this is one of the most prestigious estates in Burgundy, with a star collection of the finest vineyards to match. The status of La Grande Rue as a grand cru was restored in 1992. Quality has been rising steadily at Lamarche, especially since the mid-2000s when Nicole took over the vineyards and winemaking. In our experience

tasting in barrel the emphasis on *terroir*-expression and on finesse is easily evident when comparing the three quite distinct Vosne-Romanée 1er Crus. As is often the case when a domaine's quality is rising, prices take quite some time to catch up. Considering the high quality and the prestige of the domaine, it is a very good time to be putting Domaine Lamarche in your cellar. You will look back on there prices in amazement.

DOMAINE PERROT-MINOT

Christophe Perrot-Minot's wines could be described as something of a Burgundy Ultra – indeed, this word is used on some cuvée to donate tiny yields from exceptionally old vines. 'Vieilles Vignes' just doesn't do it justice. Everything is done meticulously, with rigorous sorting to ensure cuvées in great health. The style is modern – de-stemmed, cold pre-soaking – but since about ten years ago the wines have lightened to a delightfully transparent expression. Gentler pumping over has largely replaced punching down, and new oak has been paired back to 25% for village, 40% for 1er Cru and 50% for grand cru. The incredible low-yield fruit, and the lighter touch make these very special indeed. Tiny quantities made of thrilling quality.

DOMAINE EMMANUEL ROUGET

Rouget began making his own Echezeaux in 1985, trained by and mentored by Henri Mayer. Rouget assisted Mayer at his domaine, and so learned his craft by the greatest Burgundy vigneron of a generation.

In 1989 the first Cros Parantoux under the Rouget label appeared, sitting alongside that of Méo-Camuzet and Henri Mayer (Mayer retired – officially – in 1991, but Cros Parantoux, in small quantities, continued at Domaine Henri Mayer until the 2001 vintage). It is this vineyard that is perhaps most closely associated with Henri Mayer, because it was Mayer who brought it back from desolation, the first vintage appearing with this name in 1978.



The wines from Domaine Emmanuel Rouget share much of the energy and reserve of Mayer's. These are immaculately made wines with a sense of depth and wildness, that reward cellaring.

In style, Beaumonts is fragrant and fleshy with an enticing 'Vosne-spice' character – its the most seductive of the three. The Echezeaux is perhaps the grandest of the three, showing power and concentration, with supple texture. The Cros Parantoux is perhaps the slowest to evolve, the most reserved, with intensity close to that of the Echezeaux, but with real tensile strength, precision and purity of expression. It is the most intellectually interesting of the three in my view, but also requires the most patience. But do not overlook the 'lesser' appellations here. Guillaume is passionate about them and it shows in the quality. We are also big fans of the tangy Aligote.
