The 2017 Growing Season & Harvest

By a close shave, Burgundy avoided the terrible frost damage which had devastated many vineyards in April 2016. At the same period in 2017, temperatures plummeted, but growers were better prepared. Some lit candles or burners, between the rows. Many came together to organise the burning of bales of straw at the end of vineyard-rows. These actions warmed the air, produced protective smoke, and broadly saved the crop for many growers.

May was warm, bringing an early flowering, which went through well, in spite of some storms. June brought heat spikes at the end of the month. These months were dangerous ones, as there was pressure from mildew, against which top Domaines were able to act with frequent, preventative sprayings. Temperatures fluctuated during July, with rainy periods, which meant that pressure from mildew was always a danger, but fewer treatments proved to be necessary than in 2016.

During the summer it became evident that some vines which had been badly frosted the previous year were compensating, by promising an abundant crop. Conscientious growers, therefore, thinned the harvest where it was necessary. Others, however, left the fruit on the vines, fearful of possible hail to come. Early August was not as warm as normal, but then hot weather arrived towards the end of the month, with 20mm. of beneficial rain, just before final ripening. Pinot Noir needs sun, but not too much – so these were pretty ideal conditions for a fine harvest.

The vintage began in late August for certain white wines, and in early September for many reds. It was a normal-sized crop of whites, but a generous, or sometimes enormous

one, for reds. The picking and sorting took longer than many growers ever remembered. Permitted yields were raised, in recognition of the fine potential quality and volume, and to compensate growers for their frost-losses the previous year. But this highlights the quality-crux of the vintage: big volumes of reds mean that some lack fruit density. Of course, we have born this carefully in mind, while making our selections.

The 2017 Reds

We have been utterly seduced by the bright, fresh fruity characters and elegant textures of these charming 2017 reds. However, care is needed: due to the size of the crop, not all reds were extremely ripe on picking, so we encountered some vegetal, leafy aromas, and some wines with low acidity. These wines we have avoided. The best have vibrant, purple colouring, with vivacious, plentiful aromas, and excellent fruitiness, with supple tannins, in fine balance. Many wines will make delicious drinking while youthful, while others – where growers managed yields and extractions with skill – have an excellent future ahead of them.

The 2017 Whites

This is a top vintage for whites, from Chablis down to Chassagne-Montrachet. Domaines have produced a normal sized-crop of often piercingly fruity, crisp, long flavoured wines. We are thrilled to introduce to our list for the first time a direct shipment from the outstanding Meursault estate of Michel Bouzereau. Owner Jean-Baptiste Bouzereau breathed a sigh of relief, after several vintages of frost or hail, to find generous rows of barrels in his cellar, filled with wines of such beautiful quality.



A NOTE ON BUYING 2017s

Visits to the cellars of Burgundy in June and November last year were full of smiles from both the vigneron and The Fine Wine Experience team. There's a tendency to think of Burgundy wine for its particular style and absolute quality in the glass. A 75cl bottle is a 75cl bottle, and it is easy to forget what an impact yield can have on the income of a domaine. The smiles came because, in addition to an expression and quality we could taste from barrel, happily Burgundy – by and large – achieved a normal yield. Cellars were flush with a happy complement of barrels. My notes from various cellars are full of words like plump, and fruity, and rounded for the '17s of both colours. More than one grower commented that – for reds – the vintage reminded them of 2014, but with a bit more intensity. Guillaume Rouget commented that in 2017 malolactic fermentations had gone through quickly as a result of lower acidity levels. He thinks the style of 2017 is a mix of 2014 and 2015 – charm and power.

Time will tell the final reputation of the year, but I think we are going to be happy with having these wines in our cellars.

Please note that for Domaine Claude Dugat, Emmanuel Rouget and Bachelet, the new release is 2016, not 2017.

Of course, Burgundy is far more than elite vineyards and names, and there is tremendous value to be found by looking beyond these limits. Village level wines are going to offer terrific drinking. For advice, please get in touch.

HOSPICES DE BEAUNE BACKGROUND Q&A

Q: What is the Hospices de Beaune?

A: Dating back many centuries with a mission to take care of the poor, today this organization acts as both a charity in Burgundy and a modern hospital. Vineyard land donations over the centuries make the Hospices a large wine domaine, but, uniquely, each year the Hospices de Beaune auctions off all its production in one day-long sale as young wine in barrel.

Q: How do you get a barrel of Hospices de Beaune?

A: By auction, which takes place on the third Sunday of each November, and the wine sold - by the barrel - is super young, coming from grapes picked the same year, so it's just a few weeks old. For decades only the Burgundy wine négociants themselves could go to this auction and buy the barrels of wine, but since 2005 Christie's have been running it, so all Christie's clients can participate. To buy at this auction, you would still have to buy a whole barrel of the wine you want, organise for a Burgundy producer to take care of it for you and eventually bottle it. But through us, all this is taken care of.

Q: So, why buy Hospices de Beaune Burgundy?

A: First, the wines are good, and indeed we could call the Hospices de Beaune a 'domaine on the rise', with great strides being made by winemaker Ludivine Griveau. They are not as spectacular as the very best names in Burgundy, but the wines are well-made, deliciously drinkable and enjoyable, and ageworthy too. Many today - including our 2017 selections, I would buy on wine quality alone. However, key reasons to get involved are also to have your own name on the label and to support this great charity in the process.

Q: What makes these bottles special?

A: I have found over the years that these wines have provided a lot of fun - both opening at family gatherings, parties, and so on, not to mention seeing the wine's evolution in bottle. They've made perfect gifts too. You may choose to do the same, or you may wish to mark the occasion of the birth of a child, a marriage, an anniversary, an engagement, and so on. This purchase of a share of a barrel of Hospices de Beaune is ideal as you will have a wine to enjoy and to keep, and it will have your name (or the child's name, or the couple's names) printed officially on the label.

DOMAINE AMIOT-SERVELLE

The 8ha organic (since 2008) domaine was established in 1990 when Christian Amiot married Elisabeth Servelle. It's located in the heart of Chambolle-Musigny. Daughter Prune joined as winemaker in 2011, and in 2017 the handover from Christian to Prune was complete. Full phenolic ripeness and a clean temperature-controlled method is the key, with the rest of the approach to winemaking varying depending on the vintage – for example the proportion of whole bunches used, and the amount of new oak (around 20% for village and 40-70% for the 1er crus). The work is done the same way for each vat of the various village and 1er crus as the goal is for the *terroir* to show through in the wines rather than the winemaking. The high proportion of limestone in the soil delivers minerally driven, elegantly fragrant wines (though Derrière-la-Grange is more masculine in style and is a specialty of the domaine).

DOMAINE AUDIFFRED

Henri Audiffred runs this 5ha estate in Vosne-Romanée. He took up the reins in 2003, and began working full time at his own estate in 2007 after 14 years working at Domaine de la Romanée-Conti. He has since applied what he learned at The Domaine about vineyard cultivation to working at his own estate. Vinification is quite different however – his search for the natural expression of the *terroir* has led him to adopt 100% de-stemming and fermentation with natural yeasts following a brief cold soak; Then he only uses used barrels for élevage. The result is wines with a kind of direct authenticity and no make up.

DOMAINE MICHEL BOUZEREAU

We are thrilled to be able to add the wines of Domaine Michel Bouzereau to our *en primeur* offer for 2017s. This domaine was a real highlight for The Fine Wine Experience team during our November 2018 visit in Burgundy. Jean-Baptiste Bouzereau's 12.5ha are mostly in Meursault and Puligny-Montrachet, 11ha of which are whites. He represents the 11th generation in his family at the estate. The immaculate driveway and garden leading to the tasting room in Meursault are the first clues to the wine style here. Then, this initial impression is followed by the carefully polished Zalto tasting glasses and careful words and gestures of Monsieur Bouzereau. The wines are unsurprisingly tightly defined, judiciously made and appealing for their clear expression *terroir* to *terroir*. He is typically in the first 25% of quality estates to harvest each year – much like some of the most exalted names in the Côte. "These are wines of precision, freshness and finesse," I wrote in the margin of my notes as we went through the range. Bouzereau feels the 2017s will be early to express their *terroirs* identities.

DOMAINE COMTE GEORGES DE VOGÜÉ

One of the finest and most ancient domaines in Burgundy, emblematic of the noble finesse of Chambolle-Musigny, the domaine is the largest owner of Musigny Grand Cru.

Domaine Comte Georges de Vogüé is unique in its long history, tracing its beginnings to the 15th century with ownership passing through 20 generations to the present proprietors. In 1925 it was inherited by Comte Georges de Vogüé, who ran the domaine for 52 years, and is now owned by his granddaughters, Claire de Causans and Marie de Ladoucette. We are proud to have been appointed the domaine's exclusive agents in Hong Kong.

François Millet describes the symbiotic relationship between 2016 and 2017. While the former saw a 70% loss due to frost, in 2017 the vines really wanted to produce. The first challenge was to pick not too late (2nd Sept.), while the beautiful healthy bunches displayed freshness. The second challenge was to keep the cellar cool in October to prevent the malolactic fermentations from starting too soon. The young wines tasted delicious, expressively *terroir*-specific in cask in July 2018. The 2017s here have what Millet describes as an 'ease of elegance'. An apt description.

DOMAINE CLAUDE DUGAT

The charming Claude Dugat has perhaps the best smile in Burgundy, and it is reflected in his approach to his beloved Gevrey-Chambertin which aim to express Pinot Noir's "amiability". The domaine is small, and all the vineyards Claude and his son Bertrand work are a short walk from their ancient cellars – the 13th Century 'Celliers des Dimes' (built on a Roman base). There is always enormous intensity in Dugat's wines – low yields, and immaculate fruit are then aged in a high proportion of new oak which the wines swallow completely. The wines age brilliantly, but recent vertical tastings also reveal how appealing they can be young too. Fragrance, fruit richness, and a lush supple texture are the hallmarks here. Every label is a benchmark for quality. Quantity is always the limitation.

There is a tiny amount of grand cru, but we are also big fans of the *lieux-dits* village-level Gevreys which can age, but offer great youthful fruit for early drinking. For longer term cellaring don't miss the old vine Lavaux St.-Jacques which is very special (and, sorry to say, highly allocated).

DOMAINE FRÉDÉRIC ESMONIN

The family estate behind many of the great Leroy-labelled Gevrey wines of the '50s and '60s, Domaine Frédéric Esmonin began domaine-bottling themselves in the 1980s. Quality today is of a very high standard, yet still sufficiently under the radar to offer great value. Vineyards are especially old (40~50 years+), wines are made with finesse of fruit and texture, allowing for young-drinking appeal, but the depth and complexity of the *climats* they work are clearly in evidence. The Mazy-Chambertin shows typical density of black fruit and licorice we come to expect, the Ruchottes-Chambertin, from a parcel neighbouring Rousseau's Clos des Ruchottes, the silky airiness, minerality and supple succulence we expect. The 'secret weapon' here is the 1er Cru 'Estournelles-St.-Jacques'. This is a wonderful, sunny south-facing vineyard that delivers a real succulence of fruit and natural concentration from small grapes.

Both the fruit-laden village wine and the deep, brooding grand cru offer terrific value. The domaine is 9ha of vineyards all planted to Pinot Noir in Gevrey-Chambertin. The viticulture and winemaking are both traditional offering a wonderful opportunity to truly get to know the top-notch qualities the vineyards of Gevrey have to offer.

The 2017s show a lot of charm; they are supple and fruity. The Bossière shows freshness and minerality and will reward a little cellaring, while the Perrières is more spicy and appealing today from cask. With Lavaux St.-Jacques there is a little more richness. The Mazis is a little more formidable today, closed on the nose in cask, with real depth, muscle and length. It will be a real keeper. This is a really fine collection in 2017.

DOMAINE HUDELLOT-NOËLLAT / CHARLES VAN CANNEYT

One of Burgundy's finest domaines in land holdings but also wines. In the past couple of years the chance to taste ex-domaine cellared bottles of Richebourg and Romanée-St-Vivant from vintages like 1978, 1980, 1985 and 1990, it is clear that these are amongst the most compelling examples of any domaine and of a classical style. Charles van Canneyt took over from his grandfather Alain Hudelot-Noëllat in 2008, and has proven himself more than a safe pair of hands with such jewel appellations. Quality here is very high, and the sense of finesse increased.

Tasting the 2017s here was a real treat. *Terroirs* stood out clearly cask to cask, with impressive concentration and intensity, with that Hudelot-Noëllat signature of finesse. Followers of this domaine will not be disappointed.

Charles van Canneyt

For some time now Charles van Canneyt has been making waves and garnering high scores for his wines at Domaine Hudelot-Noëllat. Since 2012, he has been making small quantities of very fine 'micro-négoce' wines from top Burgundy appellations. These wines are impressive, worthy of a place in your cellar. A chance to taste some back vintages in November 2017 affirmed their age worthiness too.

DOMAINE LAMARCHE

Together with Domaine de la Romanée-Conti and Liger-Belair, one of three domaines to hold a monopole grand cru in Vosne-Romanée, this is one of the most prestigious estates in Burgundy, with a star collection of the finest vineyards to match. The status of La Grande Rue as a grand cru was restored in 1992. Quality has been rising steadily at Lamarche, especially since the mid-2000s when Nicole took over the vineyards and winemaking. In our experience tasting from barrel, the emphasis on *terroir*-expression and on finesse is easily evident when comparing the three quite distinct Vosne-Romanée 1er Crus. As is often the case when a domaine's quality is rising, prices take quite some time to catch up. Considering the high quality and the prestige of the domaine, it is a very good time to be putting Domaine Lamarche in your cellar.

DOMAINE PERROT-MINOT

Christophe Perrot-Minot's wines could be described as something of a Burgundy Ultra – indeed, this word is used on some cuvée to denote tiny yields from exceptionally old vines. 'Vieilles Vignes' just doesn't do it justice. Everything is done meticulously, with rigorous sorting to ensure cuvées in great health. The style is modern – de-stemmed, cold pre-soaking – but since about ten years ago the wines have lightened to a delightfully transparent expression. Gentler pumping over has largely replaced punching down, and new oak has been paired back to 25% for village, 40% for 1er Cru and 50% for grand cru. The incredible low-yield fruit, exceptional rigour in sorting, and the lighter touch make these very special indeed. Perrot-Minot is clear that low yields must be ensured. "2017 was too generous. We practiced green harvest everywhere." The immaculate expression, precision, charm and generosity of Perrot-Minot's wines were felt right through the range of 2017s tasting there from barrel in June 2018. This domaine offers amongst the very finest wines you can find in Burgundy today.

DOMAINE JEAN-MARC PILLOT

Fourth generation here, Jean-Marc Pillot has holdings across the Côte de Beaune but is most famous for his Chassagne-Montrachets, especially the 1er Crus. Vines are mostly very old - the special cuvée of 'Clos St. Marc' – is a parcel within Les Vergers from vines over 100 years old (The regular Vergers was planted only 70 years ago). Vine density is also high (12,000 vines/ha in the 1er crus) keeping yields naturally under control (though green-harvesting is employed when needed). A low proportion of new oak is used – 10%~30% and barrel ageing is kept short (12 months) followed by a long clarification period in tank (6 months) avoiding the need to cold stabilise. The style is rich, yet firm and fine. Jean-Marc's wines are in high demand, yet the domaine is a moderate 10ha.

DOMAINE EMMANUEL ROUGET

These wines are made by Emmanuel's son Guillaume, a sensitive and talented pair of hands. The Vosne-Romanée village and Echézeaux shown here are benchmark quality for the appellations but do try the range as the same hard work applies throughout.

In style, Beaumonts is fragrant and fleshy with an enticing 'Vosne-spice' character – it's the most seductive of the three. The Echézeaux is perhaps the grandest of the three, showing power and concentration with supple texture. The Cros Parantoux is perhaps the slowest to evolve, the most reserved, with intensity close to that of the Echézeaux, but with real tensile strength, precision and purity of expression. It is the most intellectually interesting of the three in my view but also requires the most patience.
